Trinity member (and Chancel Choir member) Wayne Erxleben will appear as a contestant on the nationally syndicated quiz show Jeopardy! His first episode, which was taped in Los Angeles in February, will air on Wednesday, April 24, at 7:30 PM on WANE-TV, channel 15. Contestants are not allowed to divulge details of their games, or whether they won or lost, so Wayne cannot say whether he will appear on more than one episode. About 80,000 people per year take the online qualifying test, and only 460 make it onto the show, so this is quite an accomplishment. Wayne reports that the entire experience was a lot of fun, and quite thrilling to appear on national television, to see what happens behind the scenes, to meet Alex Trebek, and to compete at that level.
