Representing Trinity English at the 32nd Assembly were Barbara Manges, David Goodman and Julie Heine. Two workshops that stood out dealt with food pantries and assistance programs. Many of the thoughts and suggestions were those that Trinity English already is putting into practice with our assistance program and our on-going work with Wellspring.

Other issues addressed focused on how a church can be revitalized as it moves toward the future, as well as learning how to move beyond the barriers that separate us.

In addition, there was conversation on how to deal with divisiveness in one's church, and a number of options were discussed, all with both pros and cons. It was good to see that Trinity is ahead of the curve on these and other important topics relating to social change and justice.

Work on the Building — Trinity's existing boilers are in the midst of being replaced through a generous grant from the Trinity Foundation. The existing boilers are early 1990's vintage and endured a flood while they were located in the sub-basement portion of the building. The new replacement boilers are high efficient models with up to 98% Thermal Efficiency and will utilize PVC venting.
