## ICONS IN TRANSFORMATION - THIS SUMMER

Icons In Transformation is a global art exhibition and Trinity will be hosting its only stop in Indiana. The exhibit has traveled throughout cathedrals, churches, and museums in Europe, and for the last decade has toured in the United States. More than 2 million people worldwide have experienced this transformative art exhibit. A big project requires a lot of people, particularly a lot of docents (host/hostesses/greeters). Very soon, we'll be sharing a request for people to sign up for docent training. In the meantime, we'll share a little information about what this exhibition will entail. The exhibition is not about icons, but shows how the Icon has inspired Ludmila Pawlowska's artistic vision. She says her fascination with Icons is the deep sensitivity they radiate--- they have a spiritual power which comes from the Icon itself, a kind of light. To create and capture light has always been the most difficult and greatest challenge to artists throughout the centuries. This exhibition is her attempt to capture it in her own way.
