Candlelight

This year, we are excited to resume Trinity's traditional Candlelight "in person" Service on Sunday, December 5, at 4:00 p.m. Trinity's choral and instrumental ensembles, whose members represent varying ages, will be offering their music for the season.

Recognizing the ongoing challenges of Covid-19, especially with a large crowd, this year will include a few modifications: the half hour prelude will be eliminated and several elements of the service will be abbreviated to insure its length will be 1 hour long; we are requesting masks for ALL in attendance, especially mindful of unvaccinated children and youth and the immune compromised; the service will be live-streamed for those unable to attend; an "on the go" reception – sponsored by the Women of the ELCA - will provide folks an opportunity to receive packaged cookies on their way out the door. Despite the minor changes to create a safer gathering, it will be meaningful to once again assemble for this long- beloved tradition of Advent/Christmas word and song.

Candlelight Reception
