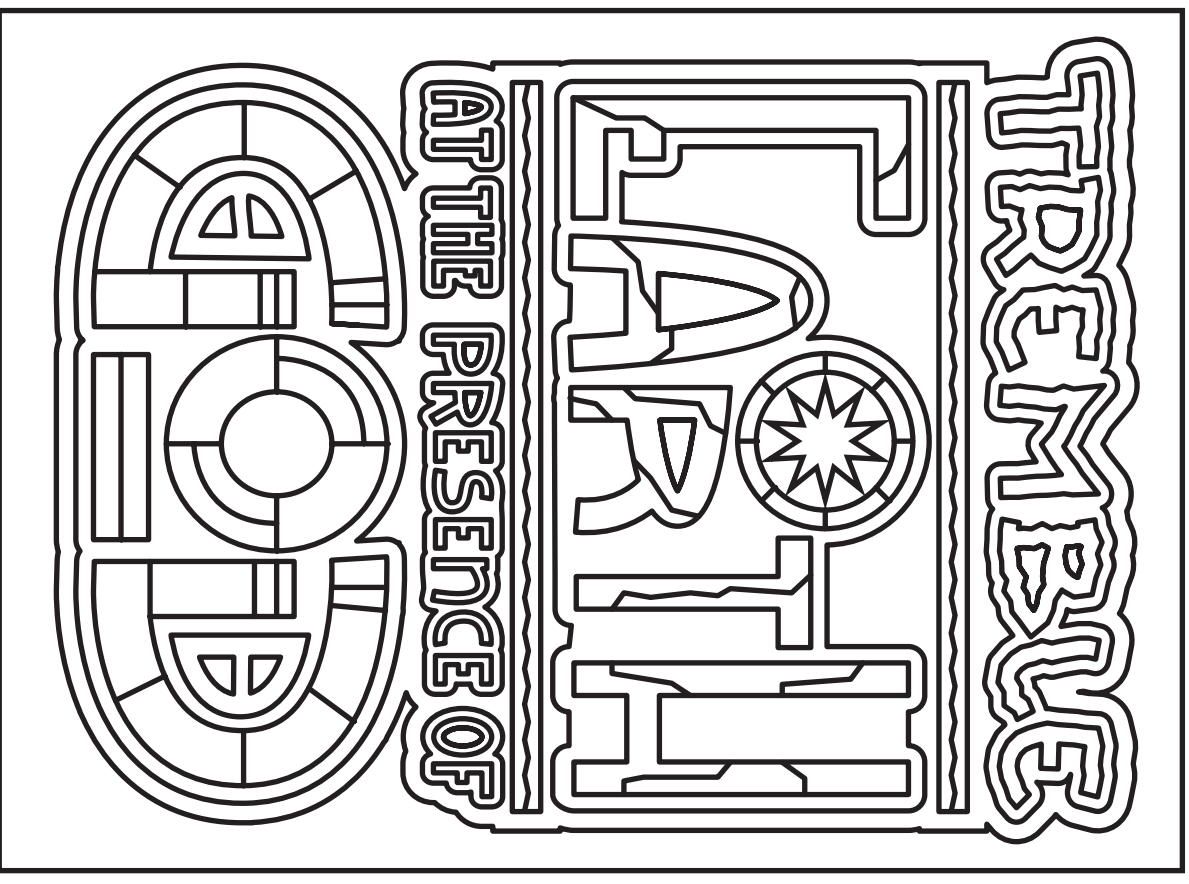

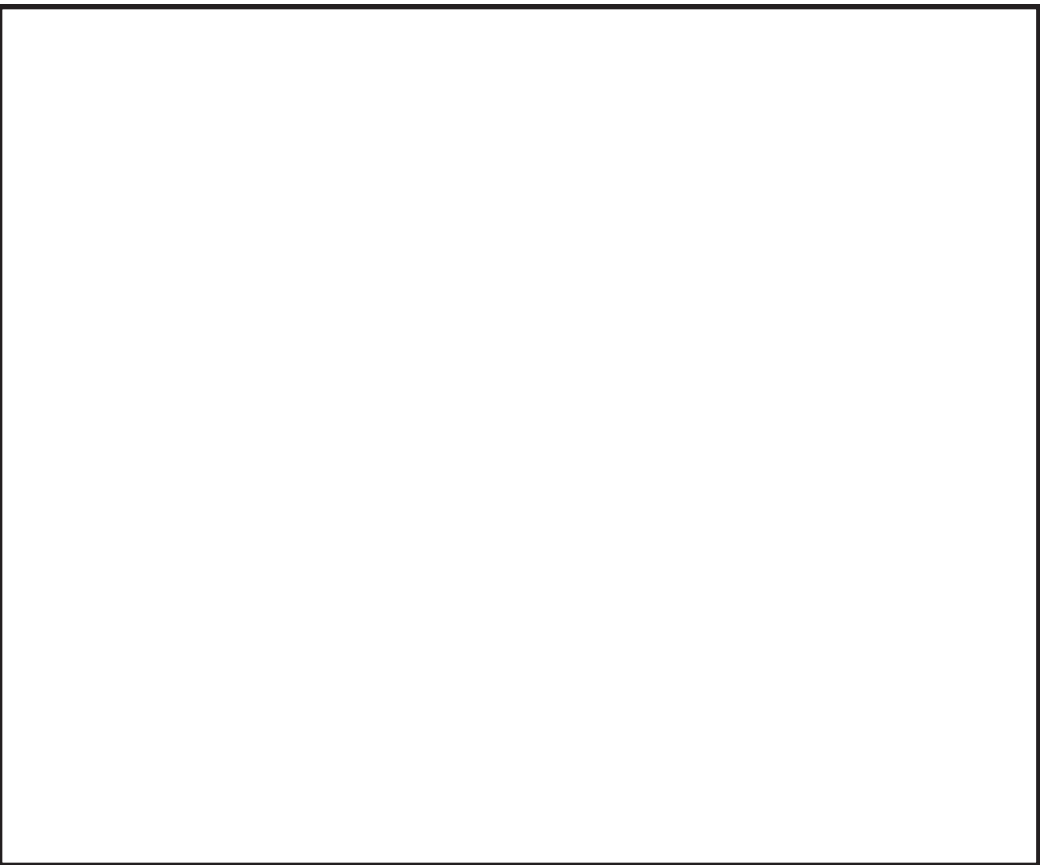
Activities based on Exodus 14:14-31, Psalm 114, Matthew 18:21-35.





DRAW IT

Exodus 14 tells the miracle of Moses and the Israelites crossing the Red Sea. When Moses stretched his hand over the sea, the water parted and created a path for the people to escape to OASsafety. Draw how you imagine this amazing scene looked.



FINISH the DRAWING

In Matthew 18, Jesus teaches us our forgiveness should be endless, just like God's. One way to think of forgiveness is to picture open hands - hands which receive, accept, and are open. Finish the drawing of the hands. Inside the hands, draw or write something you someone you might need to forgive.
